Trust a big help in rescuing at risk youth

SINCE 1998 Taiohi Toa has been helping young people and their families. Based in Hamilton East, Taiohi Toa Trust is a community youth development service working with offending youth and their families, alongside the Hamilton Police Youth Development Section.

Early identification of and intervention in the lives of "at risk" youth is the focus of the four services provided:

- 1) Alternative avenues offered to youth instead of referral to Child Youth and Family (CYF);
- 2) Keeping young people safe in the Central Business District (CBD) late at night;
- 3) Mentoring;
- 4) One on one support for individuals and their whanau.

- Success is measured in real life outcomes including:

RE-ENGAGEMENT IN EDUCATION:

Through intensive case management by our workers and regular time spent with a mentor young people are returning to school having been truant for months.

The youth workers provide advocacy, support and will act as a broker in helping the family engage with other service providers as well as government and non-government agencies.

MENTORING

Often used in conjunction with other services provided by Taiohi Toa, Big Brothers Big Sisters of Hamilton has made a difference in the lives of young people aged eight to 14 years. We have seen mentally and emotionally children blossom into stable, socially appropriately behaved young people, confident of their own abilities and ready to take on the world.

ENDERLEY PARK

We have had huge involvement here with our youth workers ensuring those who do the graffiti clean up the graffiti.

We continue this work around the city.
