# Waimarie garden flourishing

What's new in the garden? An early mushroom season soon will be, as I spent the weekend soaking some shiitake mushroom-inoculated logs which we will install in the greenhouse to fool them into thinking it's summer — hopefully!

We are now reaping our crops of turnips, broccoli, and cabbage with carrots, parsnip, cauliflower and beetroot coming on.

We have begun planting beans, broad beans, peas and sunflowers for summer and have trays of heritage eggplant, cucumber, courgette, capsicum, tomatoes, corn, cape gooseberries, melons and other favourites bustling to be planted out as soon as the frosts

are guaranteed over.

This summer we will plant the "three sisters" of beans, squash, and corn together after the Iroquois tradition. The squash shades the soil and keeps weeds down while the beans grow up the corn and fix nitrogen for all.
