### Hamilton East Development

IF you have been following this issue, you may be aware that there have been some developments in the heritage area. 33 Naylor St has been sold after the owners received four tenders. They have accepted a tender from a family wishing to live in the house and not from a developer which is great news.

Hamilton City Council declined placing a protection order on the 1890 house. On the up side, HCC have just announced that it will allocate \$250,000 to survey heritage areas in the city. It is up to the residents of Hamilton East and the rest of the city to continue to express their views on the matter to the media and Council.

### Holiday programme
