When the call you make could help keep our community safe, there is no call that is

You have several options..

- 111 for potentially life threatening or property loss/damage situations which are occurring now or have occurred very recently
  - local stations which may deal with general questions and queries and reporting incidents of a more historic nature
- Let us know if you see anything suspicious

- go with your instincts and call us when it happens. Then we can act.

We will ask lots of questions, so note dates, times, locations, descriptions, registrations and as much specific information as possible to help us follow up your call.

Neighbourhood Support and Business Support Groups are another way you can help in your neighbourhood. Contact your local Community Constable to set up or reinvigorate your group.

Community Patrols New Zealand (CPNZ) is another way to actively help in your community.
