Music Makers...leading to Young Voices for all children aged 3-12

You want to give your child the gift of music. But like many parents and caregivers, you may be unsure about where to start. Instruments and tuition fees are a big commitment. So are daily practice sessions.

Hamilton Community Centre of Music (HCCM) provides a solution. Our *Music Makers/Young Voices* programme lets **your child discover music in an enjoyable environment**. This programme, for children ages 3-12, uses the Orff-Kodály principles of music education. These principles hold that music is in every child, and that every child's first instrument is the body – and the voice within the body.

HCCM experience has shown that children often move on from *Music Makers/Young Voices* to an instrument of their own choice, with great success. *Young Voices* is becoming recognised as Hamilton's children's choir.

MUSIC MAKERS LEVELS 1-3 (AGES 3-8)

This programme draws music out of children (and so creates makers-of-music). It focuses on rhythm, singing, body percussion (clapping, stamping, etc) and uses simple instruments and movement. **Children discover the joy of music, and gain the confidence to create their own.** Music theory is introduced practically - a solid foundation transferable to any instrument.

YOUNG VOICES (AGES 9+)

Still using core *Music Makers* principles, *Young Voices* teaches children the basics of good singing: posture, breathing, voice production. It provides an **excellent training ground for all young musicians** – singing in an ensemble heightens listening skills and develops a fine sense of pitch and rhythm.

Guitar, Ukulele, Gu-Zheng, Cello, Clarinet, Violin, Flute, Saxophone, Brass (Cornet, Trumpet, Trombone, Bb Baritone, Eb Tenor Horn), Keyboard, Recorder, and Drums, PLUS a *Music Makers/Young Voices* programme starting from age 3. *Music Makers* is based on the Orff-Kodaly theory of musical education, to give your child the best possible introduction to music tuition. The programme leads ultimately (at age 9) to participation in our children's choir, *Young Voices*.
